### That's the Spirit!

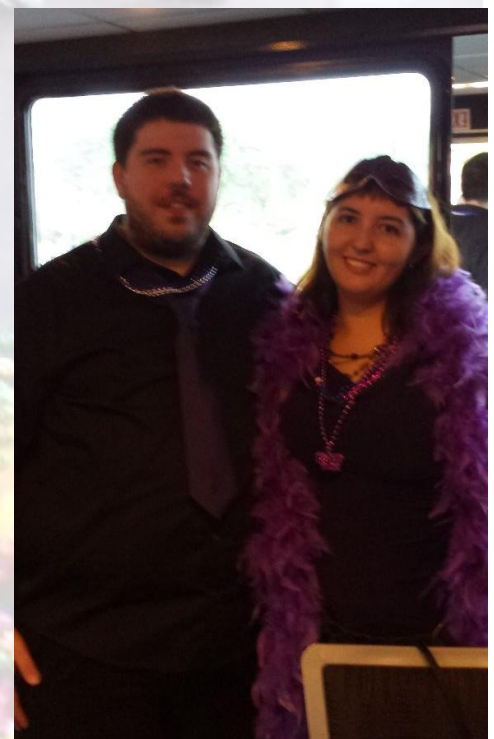
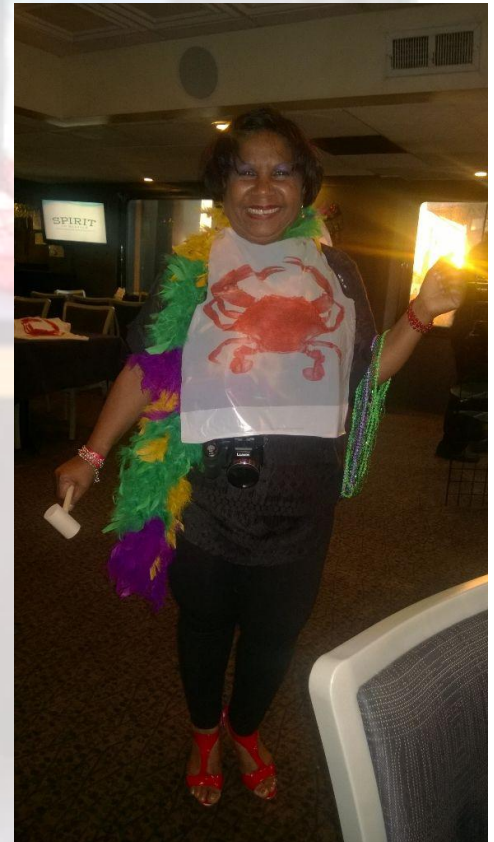
